

Learner Privacy Statement

What personal data does Agored Cymru collect and why?

The minimum we need to collect from your learning provider in order to process your achievements and produce your certificates is:

- Name
- Post code
- Date of Birth
- [Unique Learner Number \(ULN\)](#) (for [NOCN](#) and Agored Cymru [QCF](#) units and qualifications)

We also collect the following additional data, where available:

- Gender
- Ethnicity
- Ability status
- Employment status

What does Agored Cymru do with collected personal data?

The minimum data is used to identify you within our internal systems to ensure that you are accurately awarded all of the units and qualifications you have achieved through Agored Cymru and that you receive a certificate that is unique to you.

If your learning provider has supplied us with a [ULN](#), we will use your name, date of birth and [ULN](#) to verify the [ULN](#) with the [Learning Records Service](#). If you then achieve a unit or qualification from the [QCF](#), the same data will be used to notify the [Learning Records Service](#) of that achievement and contribute to your [Personal Learning Record](#). We do this to ensure you can be awarded all the qualifications to which you are entitled.

The additional data collected is only shared in order to supply statistics to regulators (Welsh Government DfES and the Quality Assurance Agency for Higher Education) and Estyn (Her Majesty's Inspectorate for Education and Training in Wales) and will not identify you as an individual.
